

ART AND DESIGN BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAM INFORMATION

General Information	The twenty-first century society is closely watched and influenced by the rapid development and changes in science, art, design and technology. More interest in original art and design works of the new century's individuals has led private sector organizations to attach more importance to art and design activities and thus to more support for "creative industries". This situation has increased the interest in the discipline of "art and design management" in Turkey as well, especially in culturally and economically developed countries. This growing interest is due to the increase in the number of art galleries, design studios and exhibitions, art and design biennials and festivals, art and design TV channels and internet sites. These developments brought together a new discipline and new professions as areas of interest for young people seeking university education. These; art and / or design criticism, curatorial, art and / or design consultancy and / or editorial, auction organization, art and / or design museum.
Program Purpose	It is aimed that the students acquire the necessary knowledge and skills in line with the aim stated above. In addition to the knowledge and skills gained, it is also aimed at bringing individuals who have developed their talents in art and design management to the gathering and humanity. Specialist managers will be trained to provide creative, critical thinking, interdisciplinary interaction, team work, artistic and design management problems, competitive quality and rapid solutions to international standards.
