

**TURKISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAM INFORMATION**

<b>General Information</b>	The Department of Turkish Language and Literature was established in 2005. A five-year training program, one year preparation and four years undergraduate, is being implemented. There are two associate professors and a postdoctoral researcher who work full-time.
<b>Program Purpose</b>	The aim of the Department of Turkish Language and Literature is to educate trained specialists and prepare them for graduate education.
<b>Degree Earned</b>	Students who complete the department are entitled to receive a bachelor degree in Turkish Language and Literature.
<b>Level of Degree Earned</b>	Bachelor degree (NQF- HETR 6. Level)
<b>Requirements and Rules of the Degree Earned</b>	Students who have successfully completed the courses in the Turkish Language and Literature department curriculum and completed the internships in the legislation of the University of Economics and Technology, complete university education.
<b>Registration Admission Requirements</b>	Students who have completed secondary education and have enough points in the entrance examination to the university conducted by ÖSYM can register for the program according to the general rules.
<b>Recognition of Prior Learning</b>	By completing secondary education (high school), the national center placement examination will be required to get enough points in the appropriate score category. If the content of the course taken at another institution complies with the content of the course given at the University of Economics and Technology and is approved by the relevant faculty, the student may be exempted from that course.
<b>Examinations, Assessment and Grading</b>	1. Exams are evaluated over 100 full points. The success grade is determined by taking into consideration the ratios of course content, midterm and final exam grades. These matters are reported to the students at the beginning of the semester. 2. At the end of the semester, scores obtained by the students on the basis of midterm, homework and finals are converted into letter grades according to the following catalog: 100-90 : AA 85-90 : BA 80-85 : BB 75-80 : CB 70-75 : CC 65-70 : DC 60-65 : DD 0-60 : FF

<b>Graduation Requirements</b>	Students who have successfully completed the courses in the Turkish Language and Literature department curriculum and completed the internships in the legislation of the University of Economics and Technology, complete university education.
<b>Occupational Profiles of Graduated-Employment Opportunities</b>	Graduates of Turkish Language and Literature department can work as research assistant or lecturer in related departments of higher education institutions. In addition, They can be experts in the Ministry of Culture, Turkish Language Institute, archives.
<b>Transition to a Upper Degree</b>	Students who graduate from this program can apply to study at the graduate programs.
