In addition to the theoretical education in this framework, a training is given to evaluate the current economic events through economic analysis methods and data analysis methods. The aim of the program is to educate individuals who can apply theoretical knowledge and methods to real economic problems and produce solutions. The Department of Economics aims that its graduates produce economical analyzes by using the most advanced econometric computer programs and sophisticated technical methods.
