

HISTORY BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAM INFORMATION

<p>General Information</p>	<p>Historical awareness is a key concept for a society to have a voice in world history and thus to become an active agent of it. The capacity of a society's participation in the process of production of human knowledge, therefore, determines its role in world history.</p> <p>A historian evaluates current events through their historical processes. This does not mean to live in the history, on the contrary it means to open a clear path towards the future. The subject of history as a science is to study, to understand and to interpret human being and its works from first man to present day through its time course with an interdisciplinary approach. And this tusk can only be accomplished by the graduates of departments of history.</p> <p>Guided by such a necessity, TOBB ETU Department of History proposes a history education applied through modern technology, embracing a comparative historical understanding. The students studying at the Department of History conceive world history through analyzing the cultures of various societies with a priority of Turkish culture and then produce authentic knowledge out of it. To help them succeed it, second foreign language education is featured in the curriculum and Ottoman Paleography courses in which historical documents are analyzed are offered.</p>
<p>Program Purpose</p>	<p>The primary aim of the department is to graduate qualified professional historians. Besides, students are encouraged to become competent in interdisciplinary studies by completing minor or double major programs in the departments of Turkish Language and Literature, International Relations, Economics or in the Faculty of Law.</p>

<p>Recognition of Prior Learning</p>	<p>By completing secondary education (high school), the national center placement examination will be required to get enough points in the appropriate score category. Courses previously taken courses from other institutions are evaluated and then decided to be accepted or not in terms of content and credits in parallel with the curriculum according to university regulations</p>
