<b>Course Content</b>	This course is an introductory course to Ottoman diplomacy and it examines Ottoman foreign policy between the foundation and disintegration of the Empire.
<b>The Aim of the Course</b>	The main aim of this course is to examine the fundamentals of Ottoman Foreign Policy from the foundation of the Empire until its disintegration. In doing that, chronologically, it is aimed to analyze the evolution of Ottoman foreign policy in parallel with the evolution of the international system. Moreover, it is targeted to examine the foreign policy implementation of decision makers.
<b>Course Outcomes</b>	The expected outcomes of this course are as follows: (1) Informing the students on the implementation of Ottoman foreign policy; (2) perceiving the place and role of Ottoman Empire in international system; (3) evaluating causality in historical incidents of Ottoman foreign policy.
