TOBB ETU Department of Psychology was established in 2012 and is affiliated to the Faculty of Science and Literature at TOBB ETU. The semester when TOBB ETU Department of Psychology first started admitting students in 2013, according to the 2013 placement results, it was the psychology department that accepted students with the highest score in Turkey. TOBB ETU Department of Psychology which started out with 4 faculty member and a research assistant in the year it was founded continues to provide education for our students with 9 caculty members and a research assistant who are experts in different fields. Our faculty members continue their studies in areas, such as attentional control, learning and attention neurogenetics, disaster and trauma, visual perception, attachment in intimate relationships, asychotherapy research, and traffic climate. At the same time, TOBB University of Economics and Technology Psychology Application and Research Center (TOBB ETU PUAM) which enables various practice activities, especially the psychotherapy service intended for our students, staff and different segments of the society, to be carried out and to be supervised by expert faculty members, serves under the coordination of the TOBB ETU Department of Psychology.
Degree Farned Those v	The aim of the TOBB ETU Psychology Bachelor's Degree Program is to create a strong background before specializing in a sub-field of psychology by adopting the awareness that psychology is a basic science and by providing comprehensive theoretical knowledge and detailed method skills with the undergraduate curriculum, and to raise psychologists who have the sense of social/scientific responsibility. Within this scope, in the pursuit of global progress in the field of psychology, it is aimed to actualize structural integrations within the program together with new developments and to raise qualified researcher and practitioner psychologists with high standards and sense of ethical responsibility by acting with the motto of continuous improvement. It is aimed that the principles of lifelong learning and openness to innovation adopted by our dynamic and expert academic staff are also internalized by our students. As a result, due to the fact that psychology can be integrated into every field where the human factor is involved, it is aimed to make our students both independent and collaborative producers with the motivation and encouragement of interdisciplinary work. With the multi-directional education plan offered, it is aimed to reveal the interests of our students in different fields in both theoretical and practical fields, and to create opportunities for development in these fields. In this way, under the supervision of their academic advisors, it is aimed that the students gain the freedom to estudents who feel the need to feed their interest and decisions. The openness of psychology to interdisciplinary work will lead to students who feel the need to feed their interest in psychology while improving themselves in other disciplines. Although the educational times of our program are oriented to raise qualified psychologists, it also aims to provide accurate and scientific knowledge to all students who desire to have knowledge in the field of psychology. Requirements and Rules of the Degree Earned	For the students enrolled in the TOBB ETU Psychology Department Undergraduate Program to graduate, they are required to; successfully complete all the courses and practices stipulated by the undergraduate program they are enrolled in, as well as the Cooperative Education obligations and all the courses that have not been replaced by another course, within the maximum period of study (A maximum of seven years for four-year undergraduate programs. The periods spent in the foreign language preparatory program are not included in the study period.); complete at least 246 ECTS credits required by the undergraduate program; have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 out of 4.00. The student must have completed at least 50% of the course credit load in the TOBB ETU Psychology Department curriculum at TOBB ETU.
Registration Admission Requirements	Candidates must have a high school or equivalent school diploma and get enough points in the EA score type from the University Entrance Exams conducted by ÖSYM. At the same time, since at least 30% English education is provided in the department, candidates must present an exemption certificate or successfully complete the preparatory classes in order to move on to the department.
Recognition of Prior Learning	It is required to complete secondary education (high school) education and to obtain sufficient points in the appropriate score category in the national central placement exam. The suitability and equivalence of the content of the course taken by the student in another institution to the content of the course given in the program is evaluated by the Department Board and the Faculty Administrative Board. In case the equivalence is approved, the course taken by the student coming with ÖSYM or lateral transfer is counted towards the program course with a letter grade.
Examinations, Assessment and Grading	Measurement and evaluation methods (quiz, homework, presentation, project, practice, laboratory, etc.) for all must and elective Psychology Department courses are clearly stated in the lesson plans.
Teaching Style	The type of education in the TOBB ETU Psychology Department Undergraduate Program is full-time primary education. Most of the courses are held in the TOBB ETU Main Building classrooms as face-to-face education.
Graduation Requirements	Conditions to be met for graduation are defined in Article 45 within the scope of <u>TOBB University of Economics and Technology Undergraduate Education and Examination Regulations</u> . Students who are accepted to the program must successfully complete all of the curriculum courses and the Joint Education Program applications for a total of 246 ECTS in order to graduate.
Occupational Profile of Graduated- Employment Opportunities	Since psychology consists of many sub-fields, graduates of this program are offered a wide range of employment. In public institutions and private sector organizations; employment opportunities are available in hospitals and clinics within the scope of Clinical Psychology, in the HR departments of large organizations or consultancy organizations within the scope of Industrial and Organizational Psychology, in educational institutions within the scope of Developmental Psychology, in research institutions and ministries within the scope of Social Psychology, and in research laboratories within the scope of Cognitive and Experimental Psychology. At the same time, graduates can work in foundations and associations that employ psychologists. Graduates who continue their graduate education can be employed in the sector as a Specialist Psychologist (Clinical Psychologist for Clinical Psychology) or Psychologist Doctor, or they can work as academic staff at Foundation and State universities, depending on the level of their education.

Transition to an Upper
Degree

Graduates of TOBB ETU Psychology Department Undergraduate Program can apply for graduate education in their preferred field by obtaining sufficient points from the Academic Personnel and Graduate Education Entrance Exam (ALES) and having sufficient English knowledge. The required ALES and English score may vary among the applied programs. Among the requirements of the applied program, there may be processes such as a science exam and an oral interview. Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) scores are also valid instead of ALES in the applications of foreign students. As of the 2021-2022 academic year, the Clinical Psychology Master's Program within the Department of Psychology at TOBB ETU accepts students. Detailed information about the application and admission requirements of this program is announced by TOBB ETU Social Sciences Institute.
