Course Objectives	The aim of this course is to explan the basic design principles to students while helping them to gain skills on the topics such as basic design concepts, visual thinking, transferring ideas to two dimension, organization, composition, abstraction. Students are encouraged to think outside the box when seeking solutions to simple design problems for the given tasks. The course is supported with extra curricular activities to develop students' awareness on 'design in quotidian'.
