

**TURKISH LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE MASTER DEGREE PROGRAM INFORMATION**

<b>General Information</b>	The Turkish Language and Literature graduate program which is included in the Institute of Social Sciences has been training since 2015. The program, which is planned to be two years in duration, is planned to complete the courses in three semesters and completion of the master's thesis in the remaining period. Full scholarship, research scholarship, Tübitak scholarship and paid learning opportunities are available in the program. Three faculty members, two associate professors and one postdoctor, work on a full-time.
<b>Program Purpose</b>	The aim of this program is to educate the scientists who can use the analytical thinking skills in this area, have scientific curiosity, produce scientific knowledge, tend to do interdisciplinary studies and produce solutions to problems with expert knowledge in fields related with Turkish Language.
<b>Degree Earned</b>	Students who complete the department are entitled to receive a master's degree in Turkish Language and Literature.
<b>Level of Degree Earned</b>	Master's Degree (NQF- HETR 7. Level)
<b>Requirements and Rules of the Degree Earned</b>	Students who have successfully completed the courses and graduate thesis in the curriculum of Turkish Language and Literature master program are deemed to have completed this program.
<b>Registration Admission Requirements</b>	Graduates of the Turkish Language and Literature departments or undergraduate programs offering four years of education can register according to the general rules and the necessary foreign language and ALES scores.
<b>Recognition of Prior Learning</b>	Students who have completed at least one semester in their postgraduate program at the equivalent institution of universities may be accepted by transfer. The student who wants to make a transfer to the program; apply to the relevant institute directorate by introducing the curriculum that he/she is attending and adding the documents indicating the success status of the courses.
<b>Examinations, Assessment and Grading</b>	<p>1. Exams are evaluated over 100 full points. The success grade is determined by taking into consideration the ratios of course content, midterm and final exam grades. These matters are reported to the students at the beginning of the semester.</p> <p>2. <b>Graduation Requirements</b>	Students who have successfully completed the courses and graduate thesis in the curriculum of Turkish Language and Literature master program are deemed to have completed this program.
<b>Occupational Profiles of Graduated-Employment Opportunities</b>	Students who have graduated from the master's program in Turkish Language and Literature can work as research instructors or lecturers in the related departments of the universities. In addition, they can work in research centers, institutes, archives and museums that are active in the field of social sciences.
<b>Transition to a Upper Degree</b>	Students who graduate from this program can apply to doctoral programs in their own field or in other fields if they have the necessary ALES and foreign language scores.
