INFORMATION ON THE ARCHITECTURE BACHELOR DE	GREE PROGRAM
General Information	Design and Architecture Faculty, Undergraduate Program of Architecture Department was established in 2013. Currently, the department has 6 faculties, 3 instructors and 2 teaching assistants. The Department of Architecture acknowledges architectural education as space and design research, as well as an experiment, experience and practice area which is approached with an innovative, distinctive and future oriented perspective. The program comprises of five interwoven and complementary modules: Module 1: Architectural Design Studios, Module 2: Architectural Design Studios, Module 3: Architectural Design, Presentation and Research Methods and Techniques, Module 3: Architectural Design, Presentation and Research Methods and Techniques, Module 4: Building Technologies, Module 5: Elective Courses. The courses in these modules are organized in a way that supports increasing knowledge and skill levels required in the year and semester they are given. Modules are comprised of courses sharing the same name that refers to the area. The vertical organization of architectural design studios constitute the backbone of the module system, with their interwoven content and targeted learning outputs. Vertical studio defines the education environment in which students registered in different years and semesters carries out the practices of the studio under the guidance of 2 or more studio instructors. It grounds on the processing of each student, who has different knowledge, skills and competence level, on their level but also aiming at the next level. The energy of the cooperation of students who are in different levels and having different expectations generates a rich learning environment. The students attend to cooperative education which is unique to TOBB ETU and the only one in Turkey, when they finish the 5th semester. Our department has cooperative education agreements with 152 firms from different working, expertise and practice areas and this number increases every year. Admission of students from abroad is carried out according to the principles determined by the Senate within the framework of the relevant legislative provisions. 3) Acceptance of students in the scope of lateral or vertical transfer inside or outside the university, special student, guest student, exchange programs or in other categories, is carried out taking into consideration the provisions of the relevant legislative on and taking into consideration the opinions of the relevant department in the framework of the principles and quotas determined by the Senate and by the decision of the Faculty Administrative Board.
Recognition of Prior Learning	The appropriateness and equivalence of the content of the course taken in another institution where the student has interrupted his/her relationship with the content of the course given in the program is evaluated by the Board of Directors and Faculty Administrative Board and if approved, adjustments are made in accordance with the relevant legislation.
Examinations, Assessment and Grading	In accordance with TOBB University of Economics and Technology Undergraduate Education and Examination Regulations Article 22, which regulates examinations, evaluation is made and announced according to the assessment and evaluation tools that are clearly expressed in the course materials distributed to the students at the beginning of the semester and according to the ratios indicated on the same forms.
