<b>The Aim of the Course</b>	As a continuation of the Ottoman Turkish literacy at the basic level learned in Ottoman Turkish lessons, Arabic and Persian rules and structures will be discussed, besides reading and writing works will be done every week.
<b>Course Outcomes</b>	To transfer Arabic alphabet texts to the Latin alphabet.
